Out of Field Notification

Individuals who are teaching out-of-field are certified in at least one area and are qualified to teach but are required to take additional coursework or testing to add a coverage/endorsement to their certificate. For example, the state also requires a teacher to take coursework/inservice towards an English Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) endorsement, when the teacher is the primary language arts provider and/or reading teacher of an ESOL student. Parents Right To Know

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires that each year, schools notify parents, teachers, and students in writing of the availability of Management Plans for asbestos materials identified in each school. Pursuant to Section 763.93(e)(12)(g)(4), this notice shall be dated and identified by school/facility affilation.

The Environemental Protection Agency (EPA) has issued a final rule, 40 CFR Part 73, Asbestos Containing Material in schools, commonly referred to as AHERA. This rule requires all Local Education Agencies (LEA's) to identify asbestos containing materials (ACM) in their school buildings and to take appropriate actions to control the release of asbestos fibers.

All inspections for West Zephyrhills Elementary, a Management Plan describing the results of the inspection, and the Action Plan to control any asbestos found during the inspection are completed. This plan is located in the administrative office of the school and at the District School Board of Pasco County Maintenance and Facility Services Department and is available for review upon request.
