# **NOTICE TO BUILDING OCCUPANTS AND PARENTS**

# NOTIFICATION OF INSPECTION FOR ASBESTOS CONTAINING

#### MATERIALS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has issued a final rule, 40 CFR Part 763, Asbestos Containing Material in schools, commonly referred to as AHERA. This rule requires all Local Education Agencies (LEA's) to identify asbestos containing materials (ACM) in their school buildings and to take appropriate actions to control the release of asbestos fibers.

All inspections for West Zephyrhills Elementary have been completed and a Management Plan describing the results of the inspection and the action plan to control any asbestos found during the inspection, where applicable, has been submitted to the governor for approval. A copy of this plan is located in the administrative office of this school and at the Pasco County Schools Maintenance & Facility Services Department and is available for review upon request.

## **Out of Field Notification**

Individuals who are teaching out-of-field are certified in at least one area and are qualified to teach but are required to take additional course- work or testing to add a coverage/endorsement to their certificate. For example, the state also requires a teacher to take coursework/inservice towards an English Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) endorsement, when the teacher is the primary language arts provider and/or reading teacher of an ESOL student.
